 - a. Van Placement (Ryan Scoular)
 - i. CMRO van needs to be placed to the side of pits to avoid back-spray from take-off
 - ii. CMRO provides 3 inch pipe to cover cord to ensure that van can be placed properly and safely – minimum of 20 feet of 3 inch pipe required
 - b. Lights
 - i. Change the sensors on start and finish beams to have them not interact -

\$1800, \$2700 if we also get MPH sensor

 - 2. Amendment #2: Rodney Hollingsworth motions that all rule changes within individual classes have a 3 year waiting period before they can be changed, OR if 75% majority petition is signed by current teched and racing members of that class, a rule change can be brought to the tech committee to be reviewed. This does not apply to safety concerns. Rich Dieser seconds.
