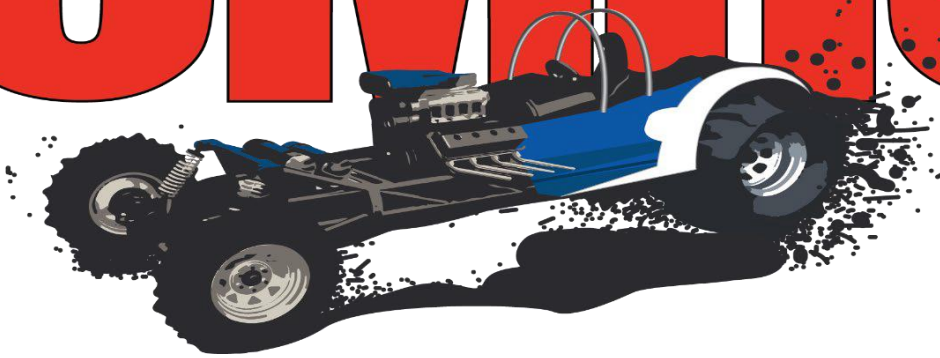

The Canadian Mud Racing Organization Association (CMRO) is a group of racing enthusiasts with the same interest: challenging the clock and each other in the mud/dirt and doing it with style.

We offer the following race classes: Jr. Dirtsters Fireball, Jr. Dirtsters High Voltage, Jr. Dirtsters Junior Pro, Street Stock, Mod Stock, Pro Stock, Open, Super Stock, Pro Mod, Super Mod and Drag Quads class. There is a common interest in promoting the sport to both members and spectators. Racing has become one of the most popular motor sports in North America for thousands of four-wheel enthusiasts to enjoy and we are proud to be a part of that.

The CMRO would like to thank you for being a promoter of a sanctioned racing event. Your support and enthusiasm are much appreciated!

The following information will act as a guide to prepare you in promoting your race event. The CMRO rules are to be followed by the promoter, participants and all other parties involved in holding the event. There will be no exceptions to the rules outlined in this guide.

A member of the CMRO board will contact you at least 1 week prior to your event to ensure all outlined rules have been adhered to. The CMRO takes pride in promoting a safe and successful event for everyone.

A penalty (maximum of \$500.00) will be applied to the promoter if the CMRO determines that the outlined rules are not being met. Your event will not commence until this penalty has been paid in full and all CMRO rules are compliant. This rule is strictly enforced to ensure the safety of everyone attending your event.

Racing Admission Gate:

- Will be responsible for ensuring **all personnel** entering the gate show valid proof of their completed online waiver. The online waiver is for all individuals, **no exceptions**. This includes emergency personnel. If they do not have it completed, they cannot enter. Instructions and a copy of the QR code will be provided to your racing gate from the CMRO.
- CMRO members will not be charged a fee at the racing gate. The racing gate will be provided a list of all 2024 CMRO members to check them in. All members must show their 2024 CMRO membership and their completed online waiver to enter.

Tech Inspection, Driver Registration and Fees:

- A tech inspection must be completed for all CMRO classes. A CMRO tech inspector will inspect your racing unit and provide your completed inspection sheet to the CMRO registration desk.
- You must register with the CMRO for any of our racing classes. Registration forms can be completed at the event at specified times.
- There is also a racing fee of \$60/weekend for all classes except our JR classes which are \$30/weekend. This can be paid by cash. Racing fees are required at the time of registration.

Daily Drivers Meetings:

- A driver's meeting will be held each morning of your event and attendance is mandatory for **all race divisions**. It is the promoters' responsibility to inform all race divisions at your event. The CMRO will post meeting times and locations on their Facebook page to assist you.

Note: All other race divisions not affiliated with the CMRO will be the sole responsibility of the promotor. The CMRO will take responsibility for registrations, inspections, and fees for CMRO classes only.

Shootout Racing Option:

- This is an additional option for the promoter and sole responsibility of the promoter.
- Payouts are a minimum of \$800.00 and are provided by the promoter. We encourage promoters to consider the shootout option. If this option is of interest to you, please reach out to the CMRO board. We will assist in planning before your scheduled event.

Advertising:

- It is the promoters responsibility to ensure that you advertise as a CMRO sanctioned racing event.



- It is the promoters responsibility to advertise the completion of the CMRO online waiver to be completed by all individuals entering the racing admission gate.
- It is the promoters responsibility to indicate times, locations, deadlines, entry fees, race divisions and a contact name and number.

- Fire Extinguishers
- Timing System
- Record keepers (CMRO classes)
- Stagers (CMRO classes)
- Pit Boss (CMRO classes)

The promotor will provide the following for all CMRO sanctioned events:

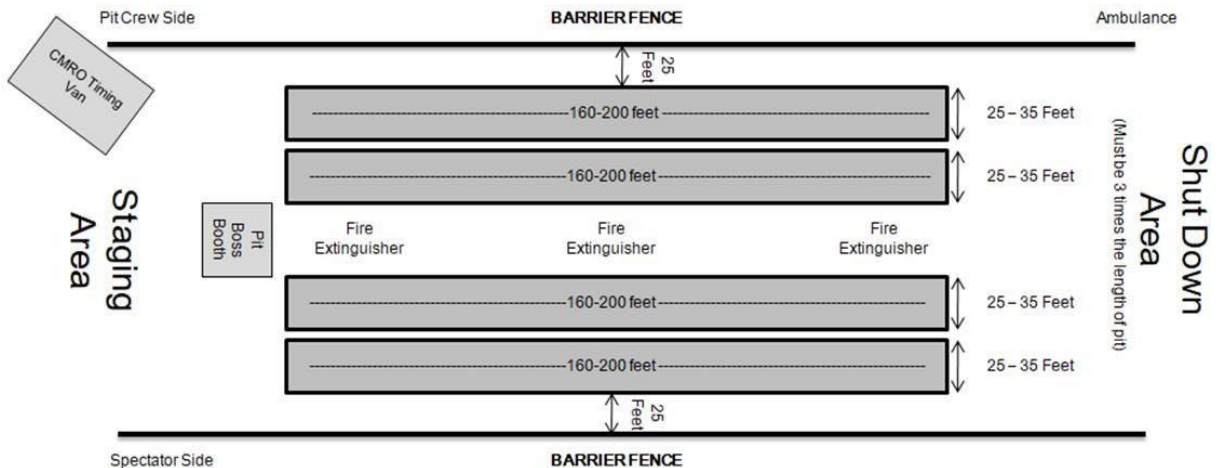
- Water for wash bay area. Minimum of 15,000 gallons/day
- Tow vehicle and operator for anybody who gets stuck.
- Designated tech area
- Knowledgeable personnel to help ensure your event is run safely and in accordance with the outlined rules.
- Fenced off area for the pit and camping area. No access from the public is permitted.
- Tow cable hook ups AKA mud monkeys (1-2 people)
- Crowd control as per liquor license
- Announcer
- Emergency personnel
- Security
- Trophies
- Sound system
- Bathroom facilities
- Bleachers
- Parking



- Admission gates
- Admission stamps or tickets
- Concessions
- Sponsors
- Water trucks or water tanks

Please note: In the racing area and racing pit area anyone under the influence of drugs or alcohol while the event is taking place will be removed from the event along with their pit crew and family. Drinking is permitted once all events are finished for the day.

- All sanctioned events are encouraged to have 2 pro pits and 2 mud pits. It is required to have a minimum of 2 pro pits.
- Approved barriers (steel tubing or chain length fencing). Picket, plastic, or barbed wire fence are not acceptable. A fence must be installed between spectators and the competition area. There must be a minimum of 25 feet between the edge of the outside pit and the spectator area.
- A non-corrugated conduit needs to be buried from the start line. (Where the lights will be set up to the area that the van will be set up) to hold the electrical wiring required to run the lights. It is preferred the conduit has minimal bends, a 6-inch diameter and is made with electrical or water pipe.
- The shutdown/staging area must always be clear of people/obstacles during the event. Absolutely no spectators in the shutdown or staging areas.
- Mud pits must have 3 fire extinguishers in place in case of an emergency. They are to be placed at the start line, mid-point, and finish line.
- No individuals are allowed in the competition area during the races, except safety personnel.
- The first aid vehicle must always be able to move in/out in case of emergency.
- Washing facilities must be provided.



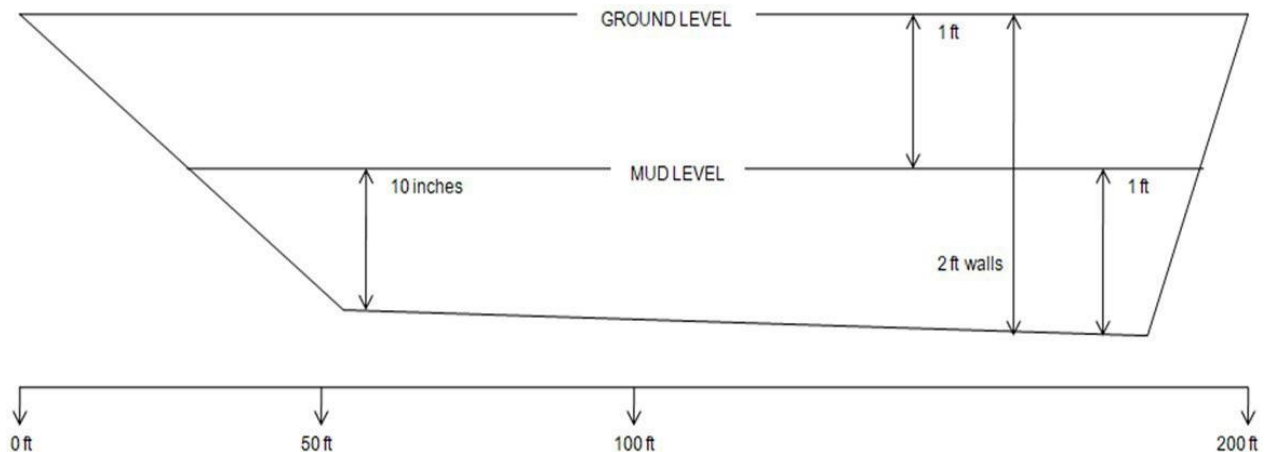


Mud Pit Regulations

- Both mud pits are to be constructed the same as above with a maximum of 12inch mud depth and no longer than 200 feet.
- Shut down area is to be equivalent of 3 times the pit length (480-600ft).
- Entry and exit slopes in both pits are to be gradual.
- The finish line must be at ground level and completely out of the pit.
- The finish line must be clearly marked.
- Absolutely no standing water.

Pro Pit Regulations

- Both pro pits are to be between 160-200 feet long.
- Pro pits have a worked-up depth of 12-15 inches of soil, clay, sand, or mixture.
- Shut down is to be equivalent of 3 times the pit length (480-600ft).
- Finish line must be clearly marked and at ground level.



BOOKING AND FEES

- All sanctioned events must be booked a minimum of 90 days prior to the event.
- Fee for CMRO to attend any sanctioned event is as follows:
\$6,000.00 (base price), \$1,500.00 (sanctioning fee), \$1,715.00 (2024 Insurance promoters share). The price of insurance will vary each year and will be determined before the CMRO race season begins. The CMRO treasurer will notify you before the CMRO race season begins with exact pricing.



- If any event wishes to provide their own insurance, they must indicate when booking with the CMRO. If you do not indicate this upon booking the CMRO will provide their own insurance and you will be billed the insurance promoters share in full.
- The sanctioning fee of \$1,500.00 must be paid in full to the CMRO, along with the signed promoters package in order to book the event. This fee is **NON-REFUNDABLE** unless the event must be cancelled or just cause is determined. In this case, 30 days written notice, must be given prior to the event. If the cancellation is justified, the sanction fee will be **REFUNDED**. Written notice must be sent to: CMROtreasurer@hotmail.com
- The remaining balance owing for the event must be paid, in full, on the last day of the event to the CMRO treasurer.

The CMRO will not be responsible for any injuries, loss or damage from any claims that may be a result of the promoter, promoters employees/volunteers or promoters' property. It is agreed by the two parties that the promoter, in signing this contract, thereby assumes such risk and liability that releases the CMRO and its members from all claims of injury, loss or damage. It is the responsibility of the promoter to obtain insurance for the event. If you cannot find an insurance provider, please contact the CMRO President:
